SPEAKER PROFILES

NINA AASLAND

Managing Director (CEO), Naboen AS

Nina is founder and owner of rental company Naboen, established in 1996 in Stavanger, Norway. She is also Chairman of the Norwegian Rental Association and board member of The Federation of Norwegian Construction Industries (BNL). In 2010 Naboen came to a 'crossroad' and developed new goals, new values and the vision of being 'The Best Neighbour in Norway' (Naboen is Norwegian for

neighbour). A tremendous growth began; turnover increased from Đ2m in 2009 to £29m in 2017 and one depot became nine. In 2012 and 2018 respectively Naboen received awards for 'Small/Medium Sized Rental Company of the Year' and 'Large Sized Rental Company of the Year'. Nina is a big fan of art and culture. She says, 'Great things happen where enthusiasm is the driving force,' and has created her own philosophy called the 'neighbour culture'. Passion, enthusiasm and trust are at the starting point of most of what she does.



JOHN BALL

Chairman, Access Link

John has been actively involved in the access industry for over 30 years. As a shareholder and as its Managing Director, he successfully led the development of Irish-based rental and sales company Height for Hire from a small domestic company, into a large international player with 15 locations across Europe at the time of his departure in 2013. During this time, John was also a board member of

IPAF and a member of its International Council. He also served as IPAF President from 2008 to 2010. He now provides an advisory service to access rental companies and manufacturers throughout the world through his company Velocity Rental Solutions. He also serves as Chairman of Access Link, the largest association of independent rental companies in the UK and Ireland. His vast knowledge and active involvement in all aspects of the access industry has earned him a high industry profile internationally.



BRAD BOEHLER President, Skviack

Since joining Skyjack in 2003, Brad has progressively held strategic positions, including Director of Product Safety, Vice President of Engineering and Vice President of Sales and Marketing. 
